Sovereign Opal, The Crown Jewel?

This rare treat is made from the only vines of this grape variety in Ontario. It was bred as a hybrid variety at the Summerland Research Station. A crossing of Maréchal Foch x Golden Muscat, it allows for the creation of a dry but zippy and sip-worthy aromatic wine that is definitely related to the muscat clan of grapes. Aromas are grapey, peachy and melony, while the palate begins with a hint of sweetness to match the full-on fruit flavours but that sweetness diminishes to a dry-ish and lively finish.

The Sovereign Opal grape is not (yet?) allowed for VQA wine production in Ontario, but rest assured that it comes from a single, small block of these grapes grown near our own vineyards. The secondary naming (by us) as a “Crown Jewel”, reflects the rare and lovely adornment that it brings to our Small Batch series of wines. A unique and enjoyable wine!
